<b>BYU-IDAHO</b>	BYU-Idaho will assess and award IB credit on a case-by-case basis.
<b>BYU-HAWAII</b>	BYU-Hawaii will assess and award IB credit on a case-by-case basis.
<b>LDSBC</b>	LDSBC will award credit to students who have taken IB courses and who score a 5, 6, or 7 on IB exams. Specific IB credit is assessed and awarded on a case-by-case basis.
